



Our Public Compliance Statement

- Breakthrough Cancer Research is committed to complying with the *Statement for Guiding Principles for Fundraising* and has formally discussed and adopted the Statement at a meeting of the Board of Directors.
- Breakthrough Cancer Research has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the *Statement for Guiding Principles for Fundraising*.
- Breakthrough Cancer Research regularly monitors compliance with the Statement for Guiding Principles for Fundraising and compliance reports are received regularly by the Board of Directors.
- Breakthrough Cancer Research considers the *Statement for Guiding Principles for Fundraising* when planning all fundraising activities.
- Breakthrough Cancer Research has a policy on working with third party fundraisers.
- Breakthrough Cancer Research provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.
- The Finance Manager is responsible for the compliance with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising*.
- Breakthrough Cancer Research ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising and its implementation.
- Breakthrough Cancer Research has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising. Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the Head of Fundraising and the Board of Directors. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.

- Breakthrough Cancer Research prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
- Breakthrough Cancer Research ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.
